Robin Becker Dance performs this **DC dance premiere**, inspired by Pulitzer Prize-winning journalist **David Maraniss's** book ***They Marched Into Sunlight***, a cultural history of war and protest set in 1967. The work explores the dimensions and effects of war on both those in battle and those at home desperately searching for peace. Choreographer Becker has been praised by the ***New York Times*** for her "eloquent simplicity" and by ***Backstage*** for her "original voice."

For both performances, Maraniss will provide an introduction and participate in a post-show discussion with the audience.
